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**Imbolc to Spring** 

Everything in its own season .

By the time Imbolc and the first beginnings of Spring roll around we are physically and mentally done with Winter. Where in past years Imbolc has been greeted with the first thaw, the unmistakable drip from sun warmed peaks, or that slight change in colour that slowly the warming ground creates in the trees ... this year requires us to pay closer attention to the barely there changes that tell us life is quickening within the earth.

Depending on your Path or tradition, some people focus on the Celtic goddess Brighid, in her many aspects as a deity of fire and fertility. Others aim their rituals more towards the cycles of the season, and agricultural markers. Regardless of the choice, the inherent magic of the season still flows sure ... it is the guickening

undercurrent of energy that has begun to rise and swell in the sleeping land, it is the energy that the human spirit has been waiting for after the long cold dark of January. So re-reading this book with wiser eyes, I'll do my best to convey why we need to remember where our roots are. It also ties in nicely with parts of the various classes the WCC offers.

Her definition of What is Wicca has been part of many class debates. Part of it reads:

Wicca honours the Divine made manifest in Nature and many who have turned to Wicca have done so as the result of a deep commitment to green issues.... Page 4.

Wiccan is a religion that looks to the good in human beings rather than to the evils and seeks to bring out the good rather than dwelling on people's faults. It does not seek unrealistic sainthood, but rather makes the best of what is there. It does not divide people into the chosen and the damned but see people as being in different stages of struggle towards the same end – that of unity with the Divine.Page 5.
